Disruption to farming of traditional crops grown in Kentucky.

- Tree Planting: We are a “Tree City USA”
- Educational opportunities for adults and youth at the Boyle County Public Library, Boyle County Extension, Garden Club of Danville, the Central Kentucky Wildlife Refuge, Earth Day events
- Residential and Commercial Installation of Solar Panels
- Active groups advocating for sustainable land use and clean energy, such as Smart Growth, and KFTC
- A growing Farmers Market and increased interest in local food
- Protection of our local watershed, by groups such as CREEC
